Main Revisions and Enhancements

V2.3.3 to V2.3.3-4

- Now provides the uninstaller. (The Studio Manager has not been changed.)

With this uninstaller, Studio Manager (V2.x.x) of a previous version is also uninstallable.

Follow the instructions below to uninstall the Studio Manager.

1. After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the file "Uninstall Studio Manager.app".
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to uninstall the software.
