

## Yamaha S90 XS / S70 XS Editor Standalone/VST V1.6.6 for Mac Release Notes

---

### Main Revisions and Enhancements

#### V1.6.5 -> V1.6.6

- Now supports Cubase 8.5 series.
- Now supports Mac OS X 10.11 (El Capitan).
- Now Mac OS X 10.7 (Lion) is NONcompliant.

### Known Issues

- After re-installation of the Editor, the Voice name may occasionally not appear on the Media Bay windows of Cubase. If this is the case, execute "Refresh" or "Rescan".
- The Editor may launch in the OFFLINE status or "Port Open Error" may appear when you: 1) select the S90 XS / S70 XS Voice via the Media Bay, 2) create the Instrument Track on Cubase, and 3) start the Editor. Even if such a situation occurs, you can use the Editor by clicking the ONLINE/OFFLINE switch to set the status to ONLINE.

### Minimum System Requirements

#### NOTE

- Note that the system requirements may be slightly different from those described below depending on the particular computer.
- Keep in mind that the software is often updated and the system requirements are subject to change. You can check the latest version information of each program and its system requirements at the following website:

Others	These system requirements conform to those of the OS and DAW applications.

## **For users of OS 10.8 or later version**

Before installing or uninstalling the application, select Apple menu > System Preferences... > Security & Privacy > General tab under the header "Allow applications downloaded from," then set the Gatekeeper's option to "Mac App Store and identified developers."

### **Note**

If you have not changed the default setting of Gatekeeper, the upper operation is not necessary.

## **Installing the application**

1. After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click a following file.  
Install S90 XS \_ S70 XS Editor Standalone\_VST V1.6.6.pkg
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.

## **Uninstalling the application**

1. After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click a following file.
  - Uninstall S90 XS \_ S70 XS Editor Standalone\_VST.app
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to uninstall the software.

## **Update History**

- Now includes an uninstaller.

#### V1.4.0 -> V1.5.0

##### <New Features>

- Now supports Cubase 6 series (64 bit version).
- Now Cubase 4 series are NONcompliant.
- Now Mac OS X 10.4 (Tiger) is NONcompliant.
- Now Power PC is NONcompliant.

##### <Fixed Bugs>

- Solved the problem in which the insertion effect of the part might be changed to off when initializing the mixing settings or part settings with the insertion effect of the AD part on.
- Solved the problem in which Cubase would be force-quit when repeating open and close of the S90 XS / S70 XS Editor VST quickly.
- Solved the problem in which clicking the [Cancel] button of the Song select window would set the insertion effects of all parts to off when opening the "All" type file of the S90 XS / S70 XS (extension: X2A) in the S90 XS / S70 XS Editor VST.
- Solved some minor problems.

#### V1.3.0 -> V1.4.0

##### <New Features>

- Now supports Cubase 5.5 series.

##### <Fixed Bugs>

- Solved a problem in which the save operation might fail when you select "Save As..." after selecting "New" from the File menu.
- Solved a problem in which Cubase is forced to quit when you close the Editor window during the Import operation when in the ONLINE status.
- Solved a problem in which Cubase might be forced to quit occasionally when MIDI data is played back with the Editor window open.

- Solved a problem in which the VSTi settings of the Editor might not be restored when opening a Project file of Cubase.
- Solved a problem in which right-clicking would not call up the menu after right-clicking on the starting up window of the Editor.
- Solved a problem in which the entire volume might be lowered to 0 when changing the mode from the Editor.
- Minor bug fixes.

V1.2.2 -> V1.3.0

<New Features>

- Now supports Mac OS X 10.6 (Snow Leopard).
- Now supports Cubase 5.1 series.
- Reduced the launching time of the Editor.
- Synchronization between Cubase, Editor and the S90 XS / S70 XS instrument has been improved, enabling you to make edits more smoothly and quickly. From this version, Editor and S90 XS / S70 XS instrument are changed to the Voice mode automatically regardless of the current mode by calling up the VST preset as Voice data from the MediaBay of Cubase or the Editor.

**[NOTICE]**

The above operation will erase the currently edited settings of the Editor and S90 XS / S70 XS instrument.

<Fixed Bugs>

- Solved a problem in which a sound would sustain while using the Virtual Keyboard of Cubase.
- Solved a problem in which the Editor would not communicate with the instrument properly when connecting your computer to the instrument using a USB cable, even though the MIDI settings of the Editor Setup were correct.
- Solved a problem in which the Editor could not synchronize with the instrument properly when loading the data that you had saved in the Voice mode of the Editor while the currently selected mode of the instrument was something other than the Voice mode.
- Minor bug fixes.
